Summer Reading Assignment

Your Reading assignment should be typed, double-spaced, and use 12 size font – Times New Roman or Arial. Students who are unable to type their assignments may hand-write their work. Please be sure all work is neat and presentable as this is your **first graded assignment for the new school year** in your English Language Arts class. Your new language arts teacher will provide you with a due date.

Incoming 6th Grade – Reading Assignment

Write a one-page letter to the author. Emphasize the parts of the book you liked best, one part you would change, and name your favorite character. Tell exactly why you found the character likeable or believable. Include the title of the novel you selected.

Incoming 7th Grade – Reading Assignment

Write a one-page biography of one character. Use any, and all information given by the author throughout the book. Write the facts about the character in chronological order, even if they weren't presented that way during the story.

Incoming 8th Grade- ELA Assignment

Write a well-constructed five-paragraph essay responding to the following prompt. Identify the book and author in the first paragraph.

Prompt: Often in works of literature, something positive can emerge from a difficult situation. In a well-developed essay, describe a situation in the novel in which something positive emerged from a difficult situation and explain how something positive emerged.
