# **Uniform Policy**

## Tops:

- Polo Shirts (Gold, Black, or White) (Mondays-Fridays)
- Long Sleeve Gray or Black (Mondays-Fridays)
- HOM Athletic Shirt or NJHS shirt (Mondays-Fridays)
- HOM Spirt Shirt (Mondays-Fridays)
- At times, clubs, sports, or certain groups will have a special shirt or attire to wear on specific days.

## Bottoms:

- Black, Gray (dark or light), or Khaki Pants, Capris,
- Solid color leggings (Black or Gray)
- Solid color joggers or sweat pants (Black or Gray)

### Shoes:

• Closed toed comfortable shoes, preferably sneakers (you walk a lot of stairs). Your shoes MUST have a back

# Jacket or Sweater:

• We sell a pull-over hoodie. You can purchase this or you can purchase a jacket/sweater to wear/bring to school since it sometimes gets cold. You must wear your uniform shirt under your jacket/sweater at all times.

# PE Uniform:

- Black shorts, Bright fluorescent t-shirt (from school store), Sneakers
- You must change back into your school uniform to attend your other classes
- Remember to take them home and wash them!!!!!

### Things not to wear:

- No Shorts, No Bike Shorts (New policy 2023-2024)
- No Skirts (New policy 2023-2024)
- No Jeans
- No Crocs, No Slides or Flip-Flops
- No Bandanas, sweat bands, hats anything with sharp points, belt chains
- No Clothing with inappropriate wording or symbols
- No Hoods on your head
- No crop top shirts. Shirts must cover your back and stomach
- If you are uncertain, please ask before you wear it

### ON occasion, we have dress down days for \$1-2. Things not to wear on dress down days or other days while at school:

- No Jeans with holes or rips
- No Bike Shorts or Short shorts (shorts must be Bermuda length, closer to your knees)
- No Sleeveless tops, tank tops, see-through tops, spaghetti straps, crop tops, shirts with inappropriate words or pictures
- If you are uncertain, please ask before you wear it.

# Things to bring to school every day:

- Lunch Money or money for snacks
